CONSTITUTION OF THE WHISTLER GYMNASTICS CLUB S-35701

Incorporated August 06, 1996

1. NAME

1.1 The name of the society is Whistler Gymnastics Club

2. PURPOSE

2.1 The purposes of the Society are

- (a) To promote recreational and competitive gymnastic activities.
- (b) To enter into affiliation or reciprocal arrangements with other gymnastic organizations
- (c) Generally to purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property and any rights or privileges which the Society may think necessary or convenient for the carrying out of any of its objects.
- (d) To construct, maintain, and alter or lease or otherwise acquire the use of any buildings or works necessary or convenient for the carrying out of any of the objects or purposes of the Society.
- (e) To borrow or raise money in such manner as the Society shall think fit, and to agree to repay the same, and to secure the repayment in such manner as the Society may think fit, and in particular by the issue of debentures charged upon all or any of the Society's property or assets, and to purchase, redeem, or pay off any such securities.
- (f) To sell, improve, manage, develop, exchange, lease, mortgage, enfranchise, dispose of, turn to account, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the properties, rights or assets of this Society.
- (g) To do all such other, matters and things as may be incidental or conductive to the attainment of the above objects.

3. LOCATION

3.1 The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in the Municipality of Whistler, in the Province of British Columbia. Satellite services may be offered in surrounding communities. This clause is alterable.
